### **ORGANIZATION DESCRIPTION:**

The Campus Kitchens Project is an emerging leader in community service and anti-hunger programming in communities around the country. Based in Washington, DC, The Campus Kitchens Project oversees all of our campus-based Campus Kitchens as they fulfill their missions of recycling unused food, strengthening communities, empowering families and individuals, and educating a new generation of service-minded adults through empowering college and high school students to lead the program.

### **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

The intern will assist with basic operations and programming at a Campus Kitchen. Placements are available in Evanston, IL (Northwestern University); Milwaukee, WI (Marquette University); St. Louis, MO (Saint Louis University); and Spokane, WA (Gonzaga University). Specific duties will be determined by the local program.

### **TIME COMMITMENT:**

CKP intern positions are generally 20-35 hours per week, depending on availability.

### **COMPENSATION:**

A small stipend may be available, depending on the hours the intern can commit and the funding available.

### **TO APPLY:**

Applications must include a current résumé and a one page cover letter that includes answers to the following questions:

- Where would you like to intern (Evanston, Milwaukee, St. Louis, or Spokane)?
- Why do you want to work The Campus Kitchens Project?
- What do you want to accomplish in this position?
- CKP is an organization rooted in innovation and social change. Tell us about a situation (personal or professional) where you have initiated change – leaving things better than when you arrived.
