SUMMER INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Organization Description:

The Campus Kitchens Project (CKP) is an emerging leader in community service and anti-hunger programming in communities around the country. CKP has locations at twelve campuses, each of which provide hundreds weekly meals to in-need populations while offering supplemental programming to address the root causes of hunger.

Internship Description:

Learn the basics of running a Campus Kitchen! Specific responsibilities will be determined by the local program, but may include:

- Volunteer Management: recruit, train and retain volunteers to support the Campus Kitchen's basic operations of food recovery, meal preparation and meal delivery
- Operations Management: lead volunteers in the safe preparation and delivery of Campus Kitchen meals
- Project Management: assist with special programming such as Culinary Job Training for unemployed adults, nutrition education camps for kids, or "mega meals" summer bag lunch service
- Program Communications: promote the local Campus Kitchen via website updates, monthly mailings to program partners, and article submissions for the CKP summer newsletter

Logistics:

- Sunday –Thursday: 25 - 35 hours/week.
- The internship does not include housing provisions. Class credit or a stipend may be available.
- Intern will report directly to local Campus Kitchen Coordinator
